Beginning in 1952, meetings to organize the Westchester Y's Men's Club were held in the home of Joe Young. Under the guidance of Bob Prather, then member of Inglewood Y's Men's Club and with the necessary membership of two the Y's Men, received their charter on May 23, 1953. They met in McCulloch Motors' cafeteria until the Westchester Family YMCA opened its doors in April 1959. Frank Morris served as the Y's Men's first president and began the tradition of the annual Christmas Tree Lot. The Tree Lot and Pancake Breakfasts have been the Y's Men's major source of income and fellowship.

During its 50-plus year history, the Westchester Y's Men's Club continued its mission to serve and support our local YMCA and its programs. In addition to major financial and labor contributions, which strengthen its partnership with the YMCA, members of the Y's Men's Club have always served on the YMCA Board of Managers and as team members during the Y's annual campaign.
